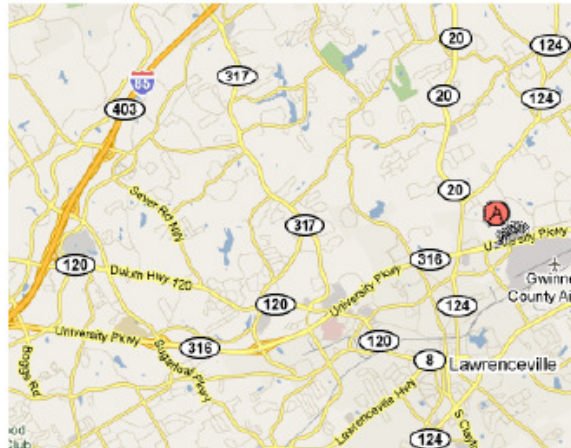

Why Take Pet First Aid Training Class?

Are you prepared at home or when traveling to administer life-saving care when your animal has that rare emergency?

What you do may save the life of your dog (or even your cat!) before you could get to a vet clinic!

The American Red Cross Pet First Aid course will help you learn these important skills!

By taking the Canine First Aid Course, you can learn the skills needed to assist your dog for a common ailment or in an emergency.

This training is ESSENTIAL for every dog owner whether showing in confirmation, agility, obedience or performance – or for a simple pet!

Prerequisites: None

Length: Approximately 4 hrs.

Topics covered include:

- Symptoms and care for common ailments and emergencies
- Recognizing an emergency
- How to approach a sick or injured animal
- Surveying the emergency victim
- Emergency splinting
- How to detect dehydration
- Heat-related emergencies
